



Two White Earth Supervised Visitation and Safe Exchange Sites Planned in Naytahwaush, Ogema

The White Earth DOVE (Down On Violence Everyday) Program has collaborated with White Earth Tribal Court, White Earth Public Safety, Indian Child Welfare, and Headwaters Intervention Center to implement two supervised visitation and safe exchange sites on the White Earth Reservation.

One center will be established at the Community Center in Naytahwaush and the other center will be located at the Dream Catcher Homes Office in Ogema. The services provided by these centers are focused on reducing the number of children experiencing the emotional trauma of witnessing a parent verbally and/or physically abuse the other parent during an exchange.

A safe, comfortable environment will be available for visits with the non custodial parent. The Centers will provide safety and peace of mind to parents who fear violence, intimidation or harassment from the other parent. Culturally sensitive visitation/ exchange services will be available for families.

The Collaboration is anticipating the opening of these two centers to be November.
